Care After Your Ectropion/Entropion Surgery

Follow-up with Dr. Yin on	
Restart blood thinners (plavix, coumadin, aspirin) on	
 □ Apply Tobradex eye ointment to stitches at the outside corner of the eye 2x a day for 2 weeks □ Please call the office immediately if you have: 	
 Temperature of 38°C or greater Any unusually painful swelling Any bleeding soaking more than a 4x4 gauze Any pus draining from incision site Pain that is not relieve by medication Any bulging of your eyeball Any sudden drop in vision 	
□ Apply cold compress (4x4 gauze in bowl of ice and water and wring out) to both eyes for 20min every hour for the first 2 days when awake.	
☐ You can wash your face lightly with gentle cleanser and water, avoiding the area of the sutures. Pat dry.	
□ Do not wear contact lens or eye makeup for 1 week after surgery.	
□ No bending below the waist or lifting anything >20lbs for the first week.	
☐ Take extra strength Tylenol for pain. Do NOT take aspirin, ibuprofen or vitamin E products for 5 days after surgery.
